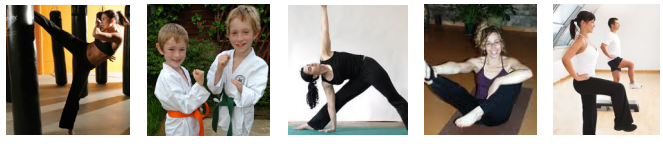

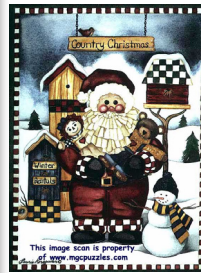
#### Fall Potluck Supper and Bingo
