Expression of Interest for an Exploratory Dance Class Classic Ballet/Modern for Boys & Girls ages 5-10

Instruction provided by Maylene Pollard.

Maylene began dance classes at the age of seven in Montreal and continued advanced studies with Boris Volkoff, the foremost specialist in Russian style in Toronto. Under his guidance she became a soloist performing in his professional company as well as other performing groups including the North York Operetta Company. While in Toronto she created her own dance company called "Dancer's Five" a professional company and began designing theatre costumes. In the early 80's, Maylene moved her career to Nanaimo, BC where she taught dance for a native Indian theatre and choreographed for one of Cam Hubert's Indian legends. She had a children/adult dance school, taught dance at a private school, taught ballet at University of British Columbia, and taught private ballet classes for figure skaters in Vancouver. In Alberta she has been the costume designer for TRICKSTER THEATRE.

In her classes, at Davisburg, she hopes that children will discover a sense of fun, physical well being self-discipline, and creative expression.

At this time we need an expression of interest to determine if we have enough children to run the class in the new year. Cost will be \$10/class for Davisburg members (membership is \$15/family/year). If you are interested in this program, contact Maylene at 403-938-1802.
